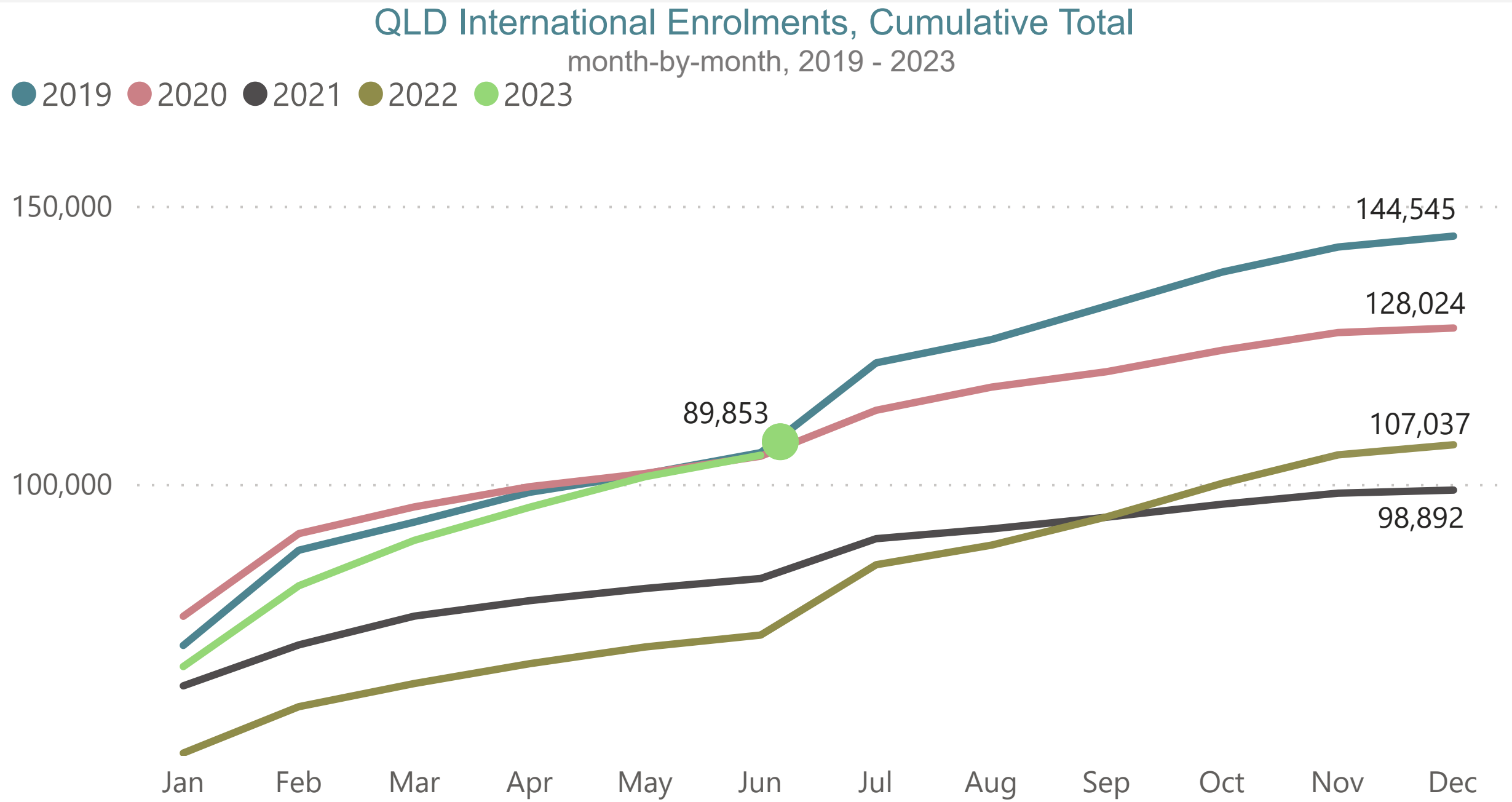

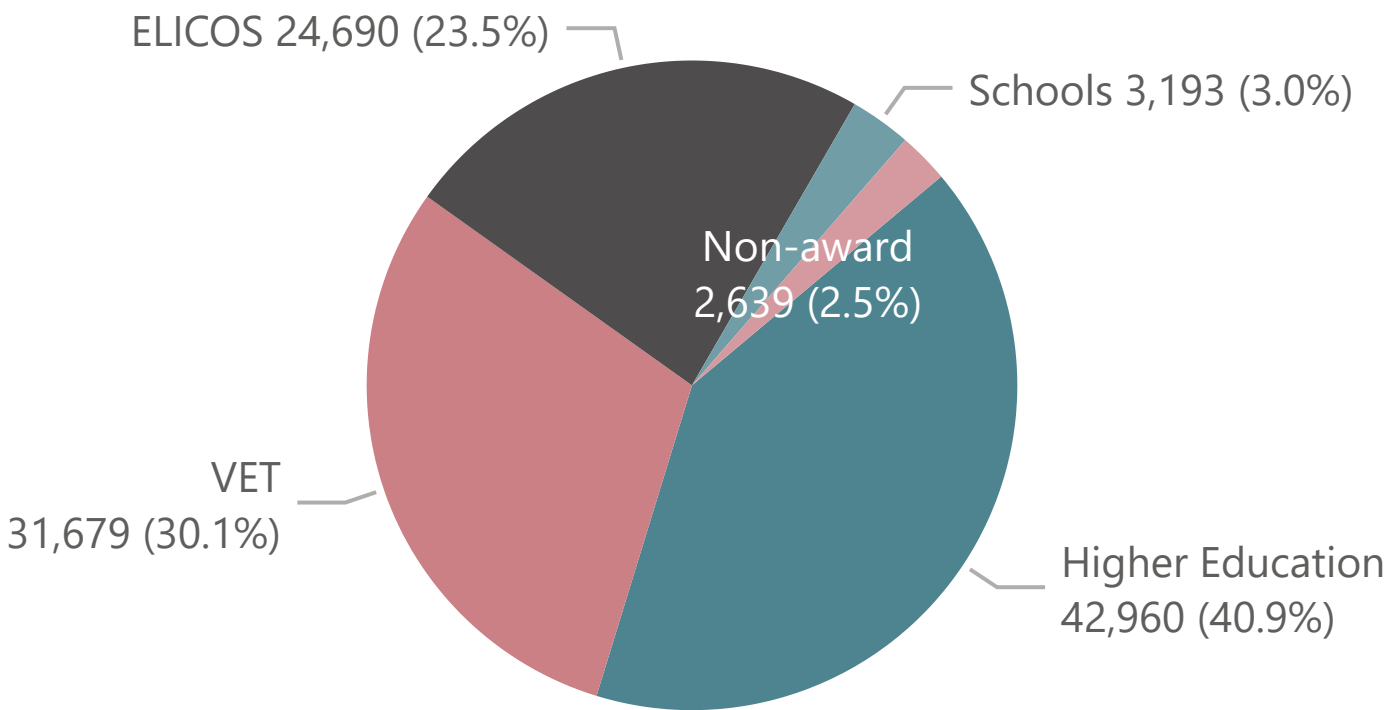

Enrolments by Sector

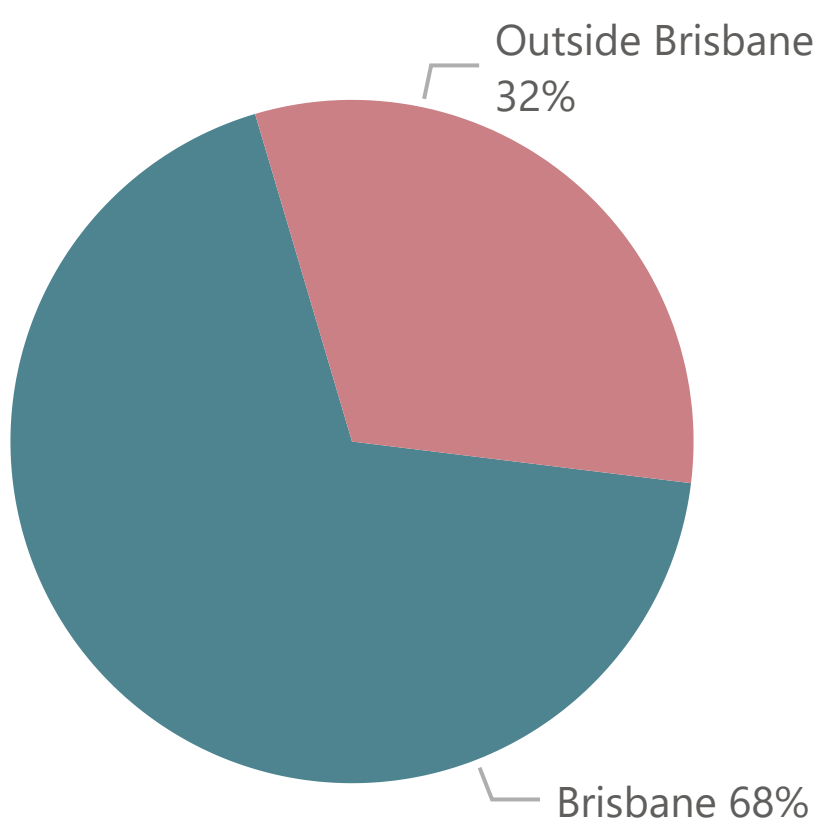

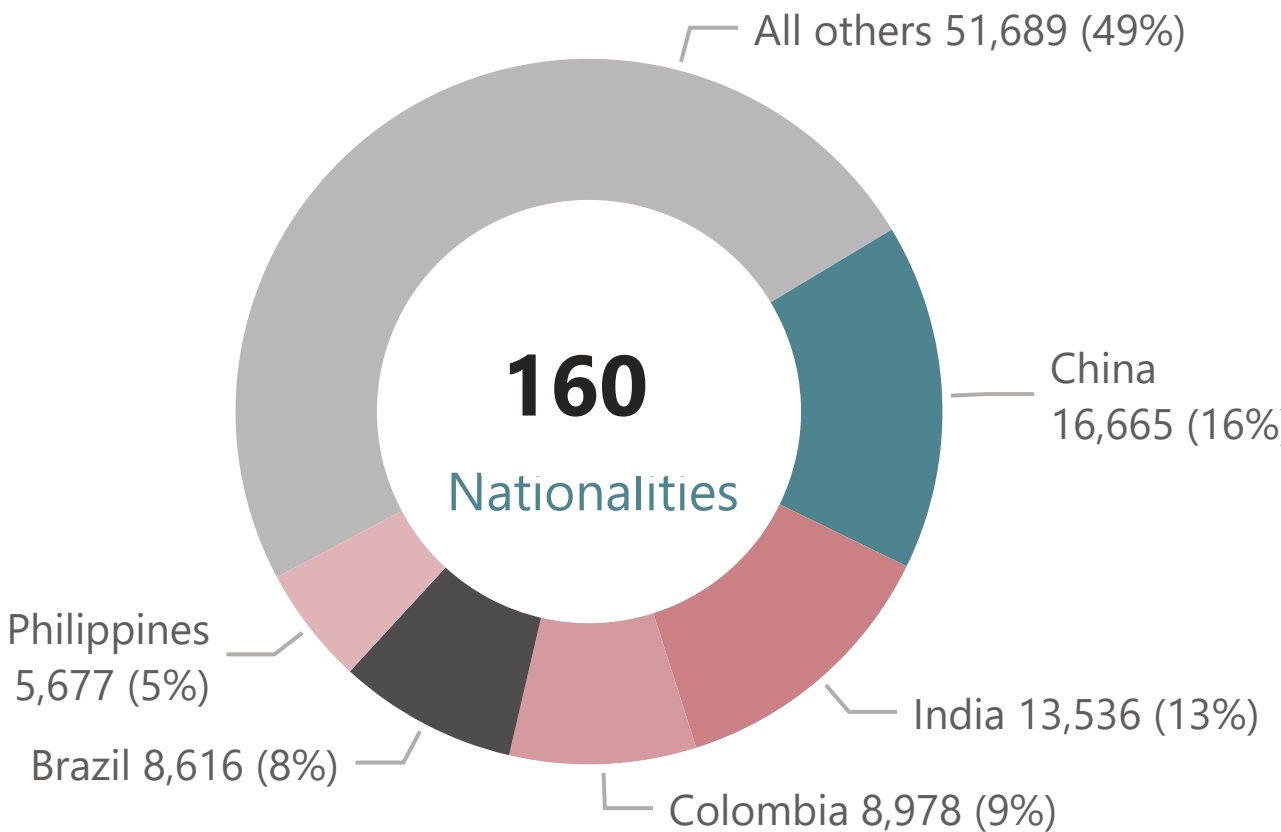

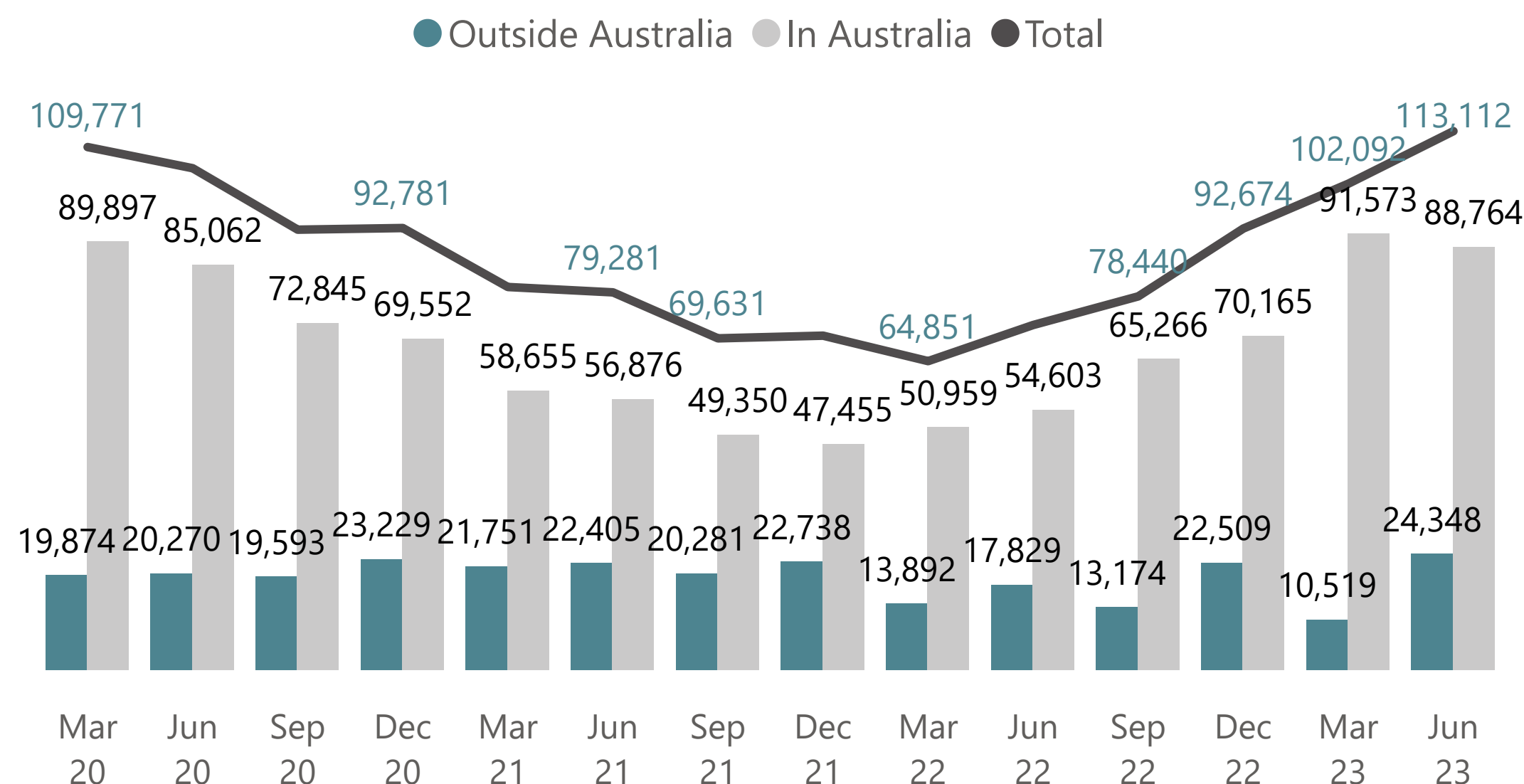

QLD Primary Student Visa Holders, Onshore vs Offshore



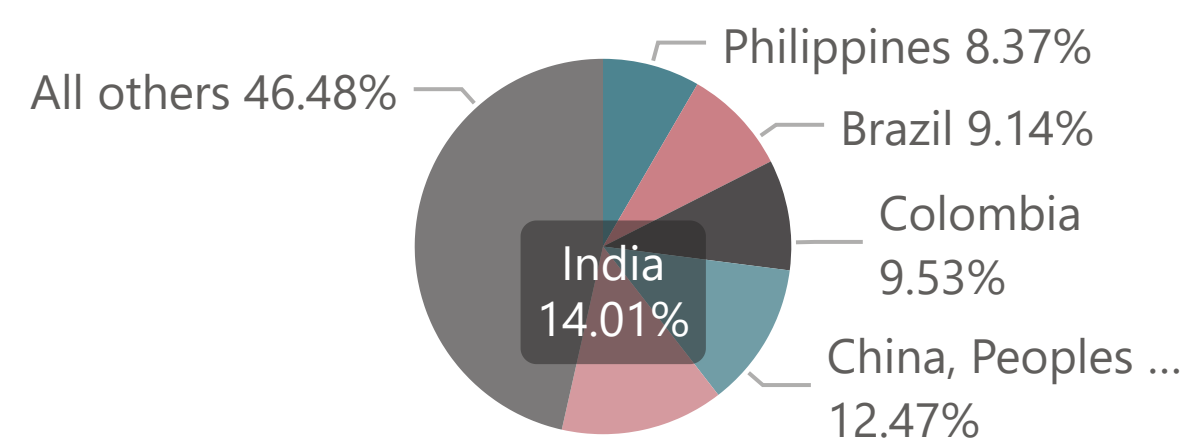

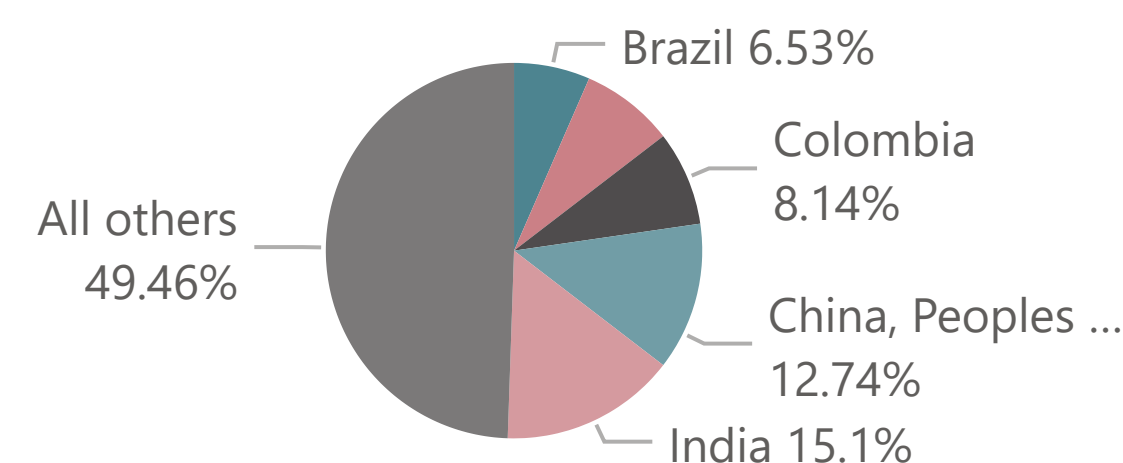

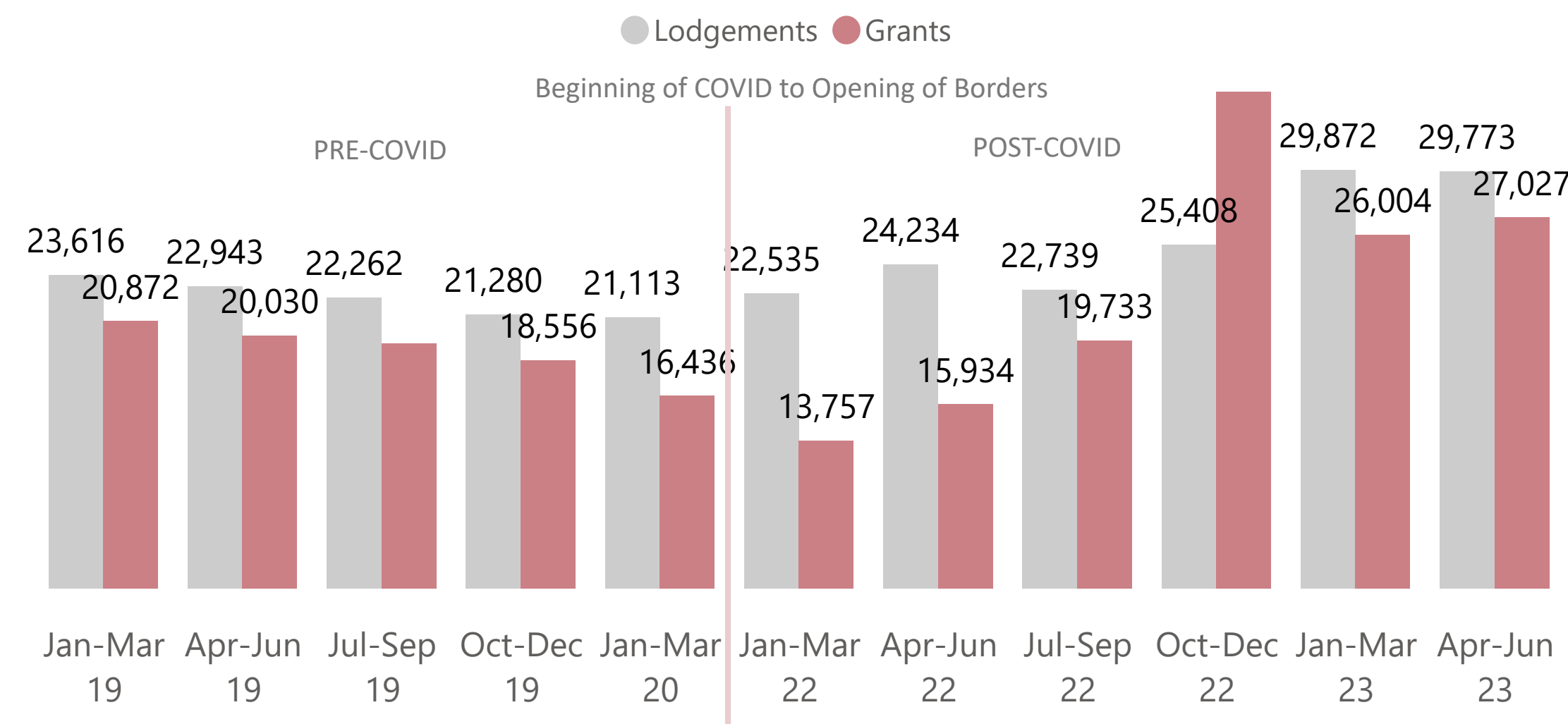
Grants by Citizenship (Apr-Jun 2023)
